

Archbishop Leo to be invested with Pallium on 29 September

Archbishop Francis Leo of Toronto joined 31 other archbishops appointed over the past year who received their pallium from Pope Francis after Mass for the Feast of Ss. Peter and Paul on 29 June 2023. They went to the *Chapel of the Pietà* in St. Peter Basilica and, in front of Michelangelo's famous statue of Mary holding her deceased son, the Pope handed each archbishop the newly blessed woolen band folded up in a small wooden box.

The pallium is a stole-like vestment, worn on top of the chasuble of metropolitan archbishops when celebrating Mass. Traditionally, they are made from white wool from two lambs blessed each year by the Holy Father on the feast of St. Agnes (21 January). They are approximately two inches wide and are worn on the shoulders.

Leo was appointed Toronto's archbishop on 11 February 2023, and installed on March 25. He succeeded Cardinal Thomas Collins, who accompanied his successor, with a small delegation from the archdiocese, at the ceremony.

The Pope gave the Toronto archbishop the box with the pallium on the day before his 52nd birthday. At a reception afterward, a gathering that included 30 Italian relatives he had not seen in years, Leo said, "The pallium is a powerful symbol of our Church. First, it symbolizes the unity and communion with the successor of Peter, Pope Francis himself. Second it symbolizes the mission a bishop has to be a good shepherd according to the heart of Christ. We are called to be good shepherds, like Jesus, for the flock."

On 29 September 2023, we will honour the heavenly patron of the Archdiocese of Toronto, St. Michael the Archangel, along with St. Gabriel and St. Raphael. ShareLife Initiates Food Security Grants

The funding consists of three pillars:
