
## ShareLife 2024

#### Halloween

Every Halloween (All Hallows' Eve), Catholics wonder if it is an acceptable holiday to celebrate. It is important to review the historical aspect of Halloween to determine if participation in the festivities merits



our moral approval. Once we realize the origins of Halloween, we find that this is a day to celebrate, not to frighten. In that vein, Catholic Christians choose to dress as saints or other characters we admire. Jesus Christ the Savior won the victory over evil when He became Man and dwelt among us.

The 2<sup>nd</sup> of November is called the "Day of the Dead," when we remember and pray for those no longer dwelling on this earth. We celebrate all the Saints in Heaven on All Saints' Day, on the 1<sup>st</sup> of November. We can consider these three days as follows:

October 31 – **Hallowe'en** (All Hallows Eve) is a time to recall the reality of hell and work through the best ways to avoid it. We remember that there are souls who are not saved, and we vow not to join them. Many Catholics attend Mass today; some parishes add an evening Mass to their schedule.

November 1 -All Saints Day. We honor the Church Triumphant on this day by recalling our great Saints, as well as the many saints who are not canonized and are not commonly known.

November 2 – **All Souls Day**. We remember to pray for the Church Suffering – the souls of the dead who are in Purgatory. Remembering our deceased loved ones and having a Mass said for them is a Corporal Work of Mercy.

If it is done with an eye toward faith, Hallowe'en can be an enjoyable and faith-filled holiday for your family. It offers an opportunity to teach children to protect themselves from all things occult. Remind others of the power of the *Holy Name of Jesus*, *sacramentals*, and prayers such as the *St. Michael Prayer*. And do not forget to pray for the intercession of the Saints – that those who do not know Jesus will come to know His love and mercy. He is the God-Man, Who loved us so much that He allowed Himself to suffer and die for our salvation!

## ShareLife 2024

Supporting Food Security

We recognize the daily struggles that many families face to put food on their tables. To combat the ongoing hunger



crisis in our community, *ShareLife*, **Catholic Charities** of the Archdiocese of Toronto and a generous anonymous donor are once again stepping forward with a pledge of \$750,000 for Food Security Grants this year. The compassion of your parishioners is critical in combatting food insecurity. They can make a difference by supporting your parish's *ShareLife* Campaign. The Food Security Grants in 2024 consist of 2 major pillars:

- \$375,000 in new funding to the *Society of Saint Vincent de Paul* Toronto Central Council, which will distribute grants to parish-based food banks and meal programs in the Archdiocese of Toronto.
- \$375,000 in new funding to *Catholic Charities* of the Archdiocese of Toronto, which will allocate grants to agency and community-run food programs.

# **Bishop John Boissonneau** appointed Director of the Pontifical Mission Societies in Canada

Bishop John Anthony Boissonneau is Auxiliary Bishop of Toronto for the Northern Region that includes 52 parishes in York and Simcoe. He was born in Scarborough and ordained a Priest on 14 December 1974. He served at the Chancery office and then from 1982-2001 at St. Augustine Seminary. In additional to his regional responsibilities, he is also Vicar for Christian Education and Archdiocesan Liaison with the Catholic Faculties of Theology.

Cardinal Luis Antonio G. Tagle, the Vatican's Prefect for Evangelization, has appointed Bishop John Anthony Boissonneau as Director (in English-speaking Canada) of the Pontifical Mission Societies in Canada.

The appointment dates from June 29, 2024 through January 31, 2026. These duties are in addition to Bishop Boissonneau's current ministry in the Archdiocese of Toronto.

Since 1922, the Pontifical Missions Societies have supported the temporal needs of missions as well as created awareness of the work of the missions throughout the world. Some examples of projects include: building Churches, pastoral centres, Cathedrals damaged by tsunamis and earthquakes, religious houses of formation, homes for the clergy, formation programs for lay missionaries, radio and television production, audio-visual materials for remote mission areas as well as support of pastoral work in various rural dioceses.

We offer our prayers and best wishes for His Excellency as he takes on this important role.


