This Feast takes precedence over an Ordinary Time Sunday. Our liturgical ministers, and especially our Lectors, should note that it is not the "32nd Sunday in Ordinary Time." 
Stewardship A gift of securities

Stewardship begins with our sharing of time, talent and treasure to build up the Kingdom of God in our world.



One of the most financially sound ways to support the Church in the Archdiocese of Toronto is a gift of *securities* (stocks, bonds, mutual funds). When you donate stocks and other publicly traded securities, you pay no capital gains tax and receive a tax receipt for the full amount of the gift. It's a great tax break for you and significant support of your Parish and Archdiocesan charities such as *ShareLife*, St. Augustine Seminary and many others.

More information: The Archdiocese of Toronto was incorporated in 1845 by an Act of Parliament as a "corporation sole," a legal entity consisting of a single ("sole") incorporated office. Individual parishes do not exist as separate entities but as parts of the Archdiocese. Thus, releases and other legally binding estate documents can only be signed by an individual with the authority to bind the Archdiocese.

Congratulations on your Engagement!

Marriage preparation in the Archdiocese of Toronto is a Catholic program for couples planning marriage. It involves classes that cover sacramental aspects and life skills. Programs are offered through parishes or through approved providers such as *Catholic Family Services of Toronto*, or the *Queen of Apostles Renewal Centre*. Couples are asked to contact their local parish at least a year in advance to get started.

How do you start? Talk to your local parish. The Priest will open an application on your behalf, and guide you to an appropriate course, and through the steps required to obtain the correct documentation.
