



# With ashes barely settled, priests vow to build again

The priests of St. Maria Goretti Roman Catholic church, which was destroyed Thursday by fire, vow that it will be rebuilt. Rev. Armand Desaulniers said no specific

Rev. Armand Desaulniers said no specific plans have been made yet for launching a campaign but added: "We'll be rebuilding, definitely.

""We have a great deal to be thankful for," he said Monday, gazing out of the rectory window at the 900 pupils of St. Maria Goretti separate school at play during noon hour recess. (The school is located less than 75 yards from the church.)
""We are lucky that the 50-mile-an-hour

winds were blowing away from the rectory, so that it could be saved and that nobody was in the church

was in the church.

"Everyone in the community, both inside and outside the parish, has offered help. The rectory has no heat and no water, but members of the congregation working with the Hydro have re-installed electricity," he said. (The rectory for the moment, contained large floor heaters.)

Several Protestant clergymen have offered their neighboring churches as temporary facilities for the Roman Catholic congregation.

"We were very moved indeed and wish to thank these kind men but will carry on in the gymnasium of the St. Maria Goretti separate school for the time being," he said.

Seven masses were celebrated in the

school Sunday by Desaulniers and his assistants, Rev. Robert Henshaw and Rev. George

Galea said seven masses were held instead of the usual five since the school gymnasium has only a third of the sanctuary's capacity.

Galea, 26, said the fire caused an estimated \$500,000 damage to the church, which was partly covered by insurance.

The blaze completely demolished the main building on Kennedy near Eglinton and two new additions on each side. The additions, built less than a year ago at a cost of \$200,000, increased the seating capacity of the sanctuary to 1,000 from the original 600, and also enlarged the capacity of the basement parish hall.

The priests are concerned about the costs of rebuilding at today's construction values.

"Right now we are trying to assess exactly what can be saved. The walls are cracked and look as if they may have to be completely rebuilt. Possibly the foundation can be saved," said Desaulniers.

Desaulniers, 54, has been first curate of the church for two and a half years. He replaced Father William Hipkin, who died in 1966.


Desaulniers, who wept as his church was gutted, said he was looking ahead to its future.


