Woman Saved by 15 flying doctors

When **Dorothy Fletcher**, a 67-year-old grandmother, suffered a heart attack on a plane an anxious stewardess asked: "Is there a doctor on board?" Within seconds 15 cardiology specialists, who were travelling to a conference on heart disease, offered to help. Mrs. Fletcher, of Liverpool, collapsed after suffering chest pains and breathing difficulties while flying to her daughter's wedding in Florida. Passengers called the stewardess and a plea went out in the desperate hope of a doctor. Mrs. Fletcher said: "The doctors were wonderful. They saved my life. I was in a very bad way and they all rushed to help. My daughter was with me and you can imagine how she felt when all these doctors stood up. I wish I could thank them but I have no idea who they were, other than that they were going to a conference in Orlando."

Mrs. Fletcher spent two days in intensive care at the Charlotte Medical Centre in North Carolina after the heart attack on 7 Nov 2003. She then spent three days on a normal ward before attending the wedding of her daughter Christine.
