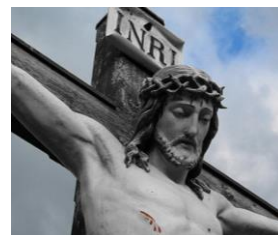

The Certificates for Confirmation will be distributed at the CERTIFICATE table in the Vestibule after all Masses on 26/27 May.



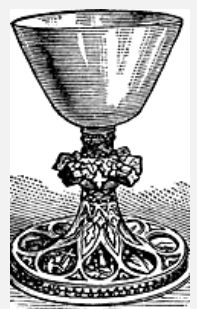

New Church: St. Josephine Bakhita Parish

On 2 May 2018, Cardinal Collins solemnly dedicated the newest Church in the Archdiocese of Toronto: St. Josephine Bakhita, located at 3200 Thomas Street, at the corner of Oscar Peterson Boulevard, Mississauga. The pastor is Fr. Mark Villanueva. The Church was designed through the efforts of the parish, IBI Group of Architects, and the archdiocese. Meloul Blamey, the same firm that built Saviour of the World Chinese Catholic Church and St. Padre Pio Church, won the contract to construct the building.

Parish Website

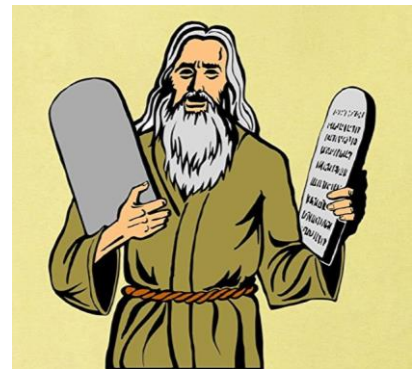
In 2017, the *Knights of Columbus* assisted the Parish Council in moving ahead with the upgrade of our parish website. Our parish participated in the diocesan PASTORAL PLAN effort to create a *standard website* format for our Archdiocese.

Many thanks to **Danielle De Guzman**, **Denis Gabuya**, **Desiree Fernandes**, **Desmond Lobo**, **Willie Mulla** and **Worrick Russell** for their commitment to this project.

Our new website went online in July 2017. On 30 July, Danielle De Guzman made a detailed presentation to our parishioners at all Sunday Masses.

The new website has made it simpler to access information about our parish and about significant diocesan events, and has been well received by parishioners and visitors alike.

At present, almost 200 parish websites have been published, with more than 60 advanced template sites being maintained. Since Christmas 2015, 110 parish staff and volunteers have been trained to use the new *SharePoint* technology, and a private training website was created with text and video instructions. Work is also being performed to establish searchable lists for lay associations and religious orders. The system is being monitored to ensure compliance with Ontario's accessibility standards.
