On Sunday, 14 October 2018, the *Mass for Canonization* of seven new Saints will be celebrated in the Vatican Basilica by POPE FRANCIS. Those being canonized are:

Paul VI (Giovanni Battista Montini), Supreme Pontiff Oscar Romero, Archbishop of San Salvador, martyr Francesco Spinelli, Diocesan Priest and Religious founder Vincenzo Romano, Diocesan Priest

Maria Katharina Kasper, virgin and Religious founder Nazaria Ignacia de Santa Teresa de Jesús, Religious founder Nunzio Sulprizio, a young Italian layperson

### 2<sup>nd</sup> Collection: 21 October, World Mission



# Sacramental Preparation


### **Reconciliation**, 1<sup>st</sup> Holy Communion: start 29 September
