# The Angelus

- V. The Angel of the Lord declared unto Mary:
- R. And she conceived of the Holy Spirit.

  Hail Mary, full of grace...
- V. Behold the handmaid of the Lord.
- R. Be it done to me according to Your Word. Hail Mary...
- V. And the Word was made flesh,
- R. And dwelt among us. Hail Mary...
- V. Pray for us, O holy Mother of God.
- R. That we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ.

*V*: Let us pray:

Pour forth, we beseech You, O Lord, Your grace into our hearts; that we, to whom the incarnation of Christ, Your Son, was made known by the message of an angel, may by His Passion and Cross be brought to the glory of His Resurrection. Through the same Christ, our Lord. Amen.

The Angelus is a prayer recalling the Incarnation. The name comes from the Latin: Angelus Domini nuntiavit Mariæ ("The Angel of the Lord declared unto Mary"); it is practised by reciting 3 verses of the Bible as Verse & Response, alternating with the Hail Mary. The Angelus is traditionally said three times daily: 6 am, noon, and 6 pm, but it may be used devotionally at any liturgical gathering. The "Angel" is Gabriel, the messenger of God who revealed to Mary that she would conceive God's Son (Luke 1.26–38).
