Presenter on behalf of Chalice

Deacon Gerry Turpin has been married to **Marilyn Gallagher** for 58 years as of August 2018. They have five adult children: 3 boys and 2 girls. They also have 9 grandchildren.

Gerry was ordained as a permanent deacon, in the diocese of Montreal, in 1981. He is presently assigned St. Veronica's Parish in Dorval. He preaches every other weekend, is responsible for the ALPHA program and teaches Bible classes in Adult Faith Formation.

He worked in public education for 33 years as a teacher and school administrator with La Commission Scolaire Baldwin Cartier.

Gerry started presenting parenting programs in 1977. He asked to be ordained to this ministry and, as a result, most of his time is spent working with families. He registered this ministry as Parentaide Plus in the mid 80's. To date he has worked with over 36,000 people.

When he retired in June of 1992 he moved into St. Veronica School in Dorval where he ran **Parentaide Plus** and did volunteer work at the school. He taught social skills and conflict resolution, helped with student discipline, and was a lunchroom supervisor. In 2001 Gerry was able to rent his own office and teaching space in Dorval.

In 1993 Gerry won a scholarship to St. Paul's University, in Ottawa, to pursue his graduate and post-graduate studies in conflict resolution and mediation. Gerry is still intrigued by the fact that this scholarship was given to him by the Mennonite Church! Upon graduation he was made a Fellow of the Canadian Institute for Conflict Resolution and was asked to become a guest lecturer at the university. Gerry has continued to pursue his studies and has now completed his graduate studies in Theology.

Gerry has presented workshops to police officers, teachers, doctors, and students throughout Quebec, Ontario and Vermont. He has introduced Peer Mediation programs in several schools and has done conflict resolution training with the OPP.

Much of Gerry's work has been with first nation people and from 1998 to November 2014 he worked as a missionary in the Canadian arctic to provide parenting classes to Inuit parents. He also did crisis intervention with native women and children who had been battered and/or sexually abused.

In 2007 Gerry was incardinated into the Diocese of Amos and was made the pastor of Mission St. André in Kuujjuarapik. In this role he was responsible for the Catholic/Christian community (Inuit, Cree, and White) on the Hudson coast. During these 16 years Gerry would spend 2 weeks in the north then return home for 2 or three weeks to be with family and continue his work in Montreal. For three years he worked, part time, at the Native Women's Shelter of Montreal where he helped women who were living at the shelter as well as with aboriginal people who ended up living on the streets of Montreal. Gerry has also worked with the Inuit inmates, at the prison located in St. Jerome.

Gerry has written 2 parenting books, one from an Inuit worldview, which has been translated into lnuktitut entitled Reclaiming Our Youth and the second, Survive Being a Parent. How to get the kids of your back and on your side which is used in his parenting programs here in the south.

Three years ago Gerry joined CHALICE, the largest Canadian Catholic sponsorship organization, which seeks funds for children and seniors in third world countries. He is traveling from parish to parish to preach the Gospel and seek support for the missionary projects of religious orders such as the Missionaries of Africa, Sisters of the Good Shepherd and the Congregation of Notre Dame.

Chalice commits 90.3 percent of its spending to support programs. In fiscal year 2017-2018, \$27,001,000 million was spent directly towards supporting those in need. Children and elders are selected for sponsorship based on need and family circumstances, regardless of race, age, gender, or religion. Each of our 57 sponsor sites, spanning across 15 developing countries, is under local direction. By working with those who experience the difficulties of poverty, we gain insight on how to best respond to challenges.
