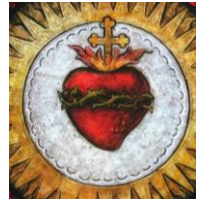

17 October: *World Mission Sunday*

The 2nd collection on 17 Oct. is for *World Mission Sunday*.

"Here we are, Jesus, ready to serve to the ends of the earth."

On World Mission Sunday, all Catholics are called to celebrate their vocation to be missionaries. On this day, Catholics around the world — here at home and in the Missions — gather at the Eucharist around the table of the Lord, to pray for the Church's worldwide missionary work. As Jesus requested:

"Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything that I have commanded you. And remember, I am with you always, to the end of the age." (Matthew 28: 19-20)

We are invited to live this Mission as servants of the living Lord. The testimony of our faith in Christ the Redeemer, our hope and our charity provide the greatest service that baptized people can offer, here and to the ends of the earth.

Vaccination for Church Ministry

Vaccination status: Provincial guidelines now require that all **Clergy** and **Staff** submit their vaccination status to be retained confidentially at the Parish Office. Lay Ministers and Volunteers must also provide evidence of vaccination or weekly negative testing, with the exception of Extraordinary Ministers of the Eucharist, who must be vaccinated to continue their service. The Archdiocese will continue to provide direction as information becomes available.

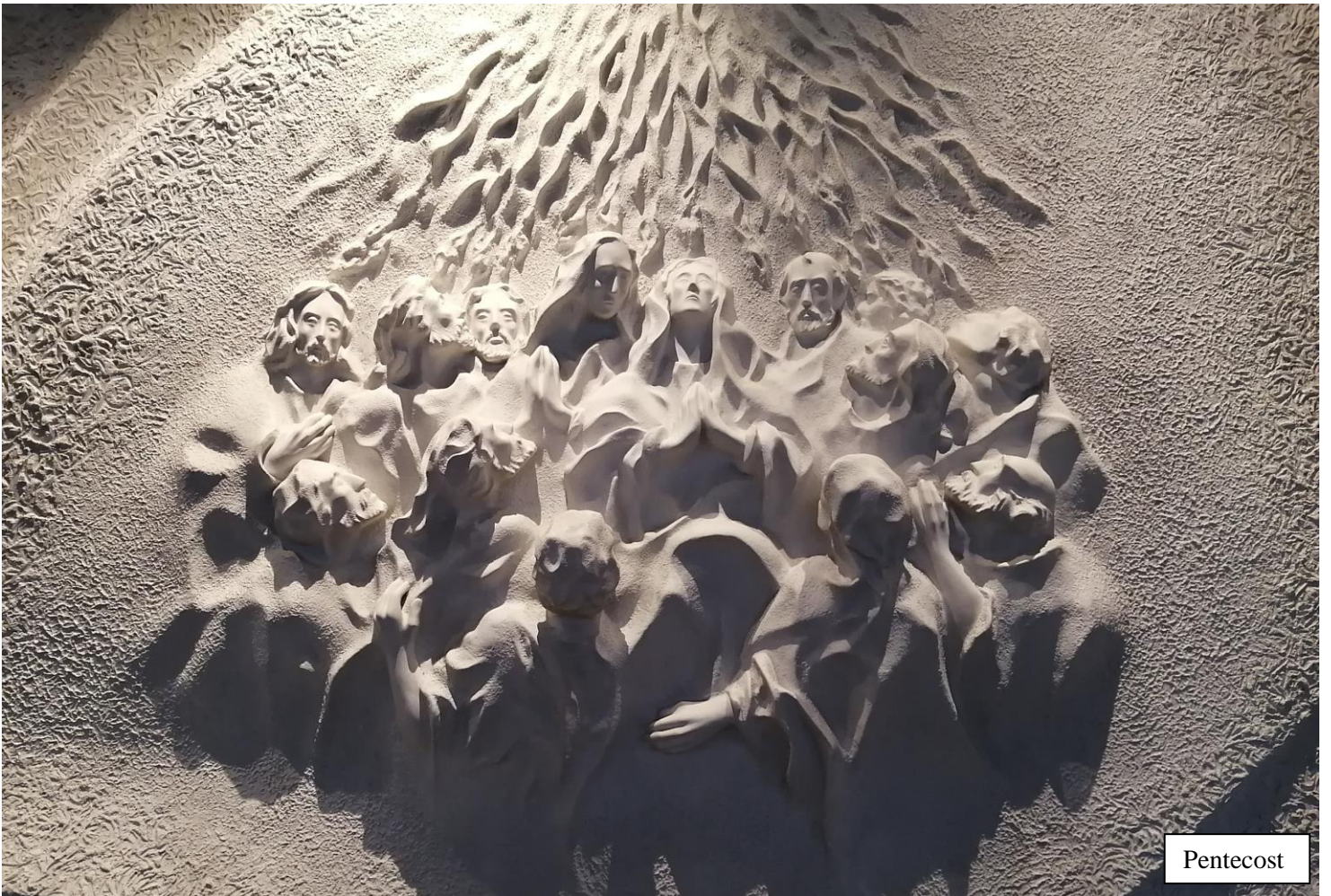

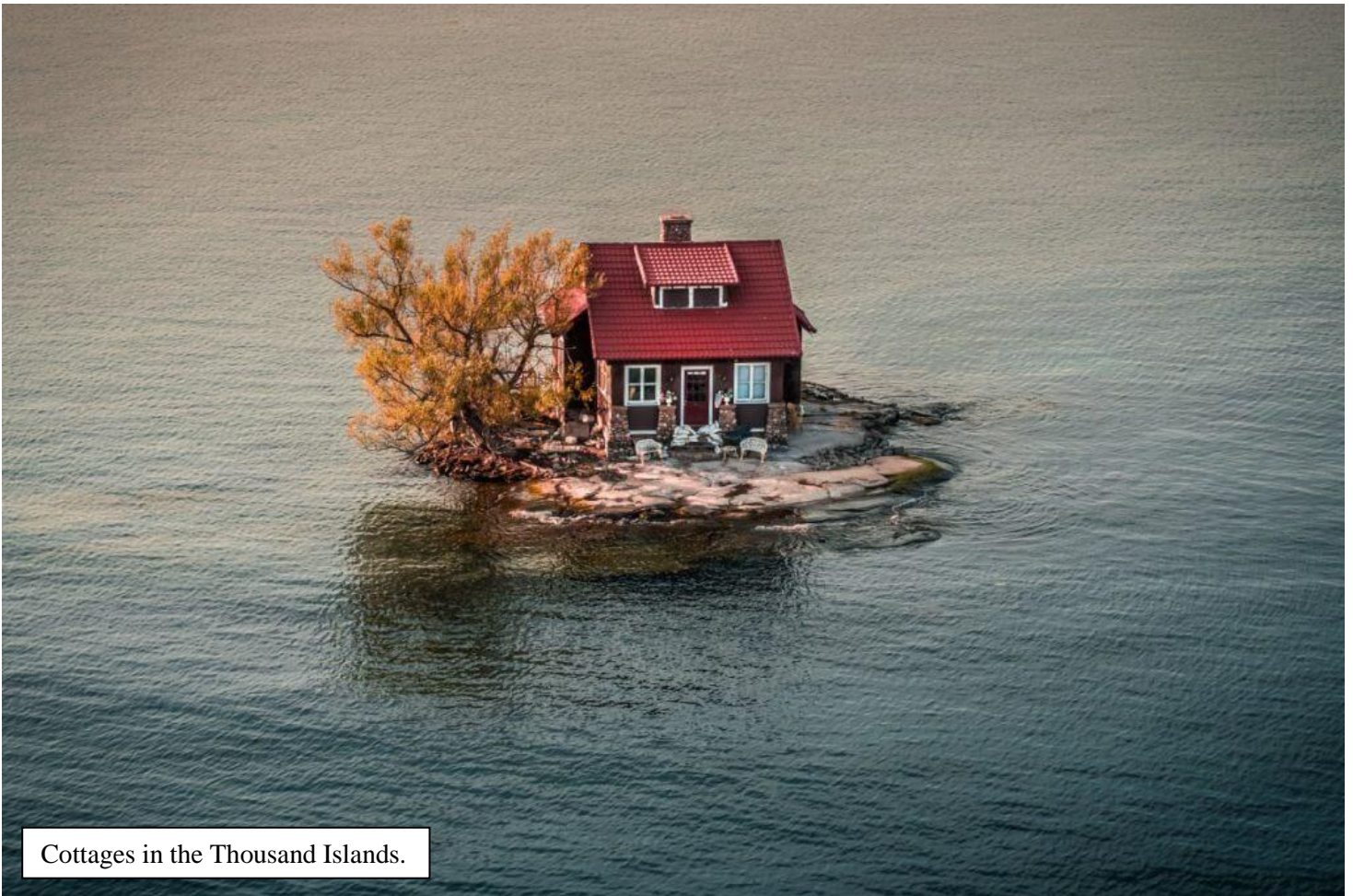
